It also includes a list of the names of women entertainers who were employed in the dance halls and cabarets in the Storyville district closed down by the government in 1917 the only district of its kind set aside for the fast women by law. Applewood After Dark s faithful facsimile, reproduced from an original copy owned by Judith Lafitte of Octavia Books, includes all of the original advertisements, including those for alcoholic beverages, cigars, and legal counsel.
